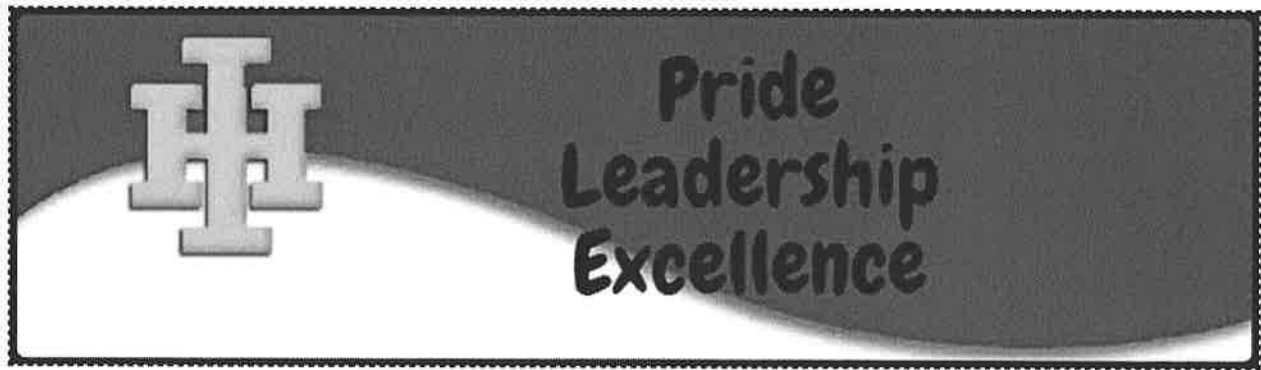

Dear Indian Hill Middle School Eighth Grade Families,

Graduation Photo!

On Thursday, May 31, 2018, eighth grade students will not be expected to arrive at school until 9:15 AM, when they will go directly to the IHHS gymnasium for their eighth grade picture. The picture fee can be paid three different ways - cash, check, or credit card.

Forms will be sent home with students this Friday. Extra copies will be in the front office. If you are paying by cash or check, complete and return on picture day (May 31).

If you are paying by credit card, you will still need to pick up an order form to complete. Then, you will need to go to mylifetouch.com and follow the online instructions. Make sure to write the online code on your order form for proof of payment. ***Students will need to bring this form with them on the morning the picture is taken.***

Eighth Grade Graduation Ceremony!

Graduation preparations are in full swing! Our Eighth Grade Graduation Ceremony will be held on Thursday, May 31, 2018 at 10:30 AM in the Indian Hill High School auditorium. Student speakers and student artwork will be selected for the ceremony and program.

Our Eighth Grade Graduation is a long-standing tradition at Indian Hill Middle School. This formal event is the culmination of countless hours of preparation by our staff, parents, and of course, our students. As your family prepares for graduation, we ask you to keep in the mind the following attire expectations:

Boys: Our graduating gentlemen are expected to wear a button down collared shirt, tie, dress or khaki pants and a jacket for the ceremony. Dress shoes are also expected and gym shoes

are not permitted.

Girls: Our graduating ladies are expected to wear a dress (any color is permissible). Regardless of the dress, each lady's shoulders must be covered. If the desired dress is strapless, or has spaghetti straps, young ladies are expected to wear a sweater or a shawl to cover their shoulders. Ladies are not permitted to wear gym shoes. Due to walking down the stairs and across stage, it is our recommendation to wear flat shoes or shoes with a small heel.
